Dr. Nancy Kassam-Adams is a clinical psychologist and researcher. She is Associate Director for Behavioral Research at the Center for Injury Research and Prevention at The Children's Hospital of Philadelphia. Dr. Kassam-Adams also co-directs the Center for Pediatric Traumatic Stress, an intervention development center in the National Child Traumatic Stress Network. Her research focuses on posttraumatic stress in ill and injured children and their parents and how parents and health care professionals can help children deal with injury and illness. Dr. Kassam-Adams serves on the Board of the International Society for Traumatic Stress Studies and served on the American Psychological Association's 2008 Presidential Task Force on Child Trauma.
